Nijo Castle was built in 1603 as Kyoto residence of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the first shogun of the Edo government.

Golden Pavillion is a famous structure of Muromachi period(14th to 16th century). It was originally designed as the villa of a court noble.

Heian Shrine is famous structure dedicated to Emperor Kammu, the founder of Kyoto, and the Emperor Komei, the last emperor in Kyoto.

Kiyomizu Temple is noted for its Main Hall on the cliff top with a broad wooden veranda and a panoramic view of Kyoto city.
