The Saitama Factory: A Dedicated Automobile Production Plant

The Saitama Factory was established in 1964 as one of Honda's main automobile production facilities. All factory procedures, from engine production, stamping, welding, and painting to the installation of engines and other parts, as well as complete vehicle inspections, are fully integrated. Models are made



here both for the domestic and export markets, including the Legend, Accord, Odyssey, CR-V, and other passenger cars.

A key distinguishing feature of the Saitama Factory is that its urban location has spurred development of vertical production lines that make optimum use of limited space. With thorough rationalization of these lines and the system for introducing parts directly into them, the flow of production processes has been made exceptionally efficient.

Further, the use of multi-purpose machinery and equipment permits production of a wide range of models on the same line, offering maximum flexibility and superior response to customers' needs. The Saitama Factory and other facilities in Japan play an integral role in overseas automobile production, supplying Honda's overseas factories with many of the parts required for local production.
